Who is the CILT(UK) Level 5 Professional Diploma for?

Aimed at graduate entrants to the profession or experienced middle managers in specialist functional areas. The Institute's most popular modular programme is designed to enhance expertise in the supply chain, passenger transport or transport planning environments in addition to building and developing core management skills.

What are the entry requirements?

This qualification is open access and no prior qualifications are required. However, centre assessed candidates should be in a job role or environment that will allow them to develop a strategic view of logistics and transport operations and to be able to review operational activities.

The qualification is comprised of a mandatory unit in Management in Logistics and Transport and students can then choose a combination of three option units – providing that at least one is taken from option group 1.
